
# Oak Grange School

- ▶ We also provide a paid wrap around care service.



# Admissions and how it all works!

## **Applying to Full Time School (Reception year)**

**School admissions for reception places 2024 in Derby City opens on 3rd November and the submission deadline is 15th January 2024.**

All admissions are organised by the Local Authority Admissions Department. If you live in Derby City and this is your local authority (who you pay your council tax to), apply through Derby City Admissions (see link below) [Derby City School Admissions](#)

If you live outside of Derby City, for example Derbyshire, you still apply through your current local council and the option to select schools in another authority is given.

# Admissions criteria

1. A 'looked after child' or a child who was previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, child arrangements, or special guardianship order including those who appear, to the admission authority, to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted. A looked after child is a child who is (a) in the care of a local authority, or (b) being provided with accommodation by a local authority in the exercise of their social services functions (see the definition in Section 22(1) of the Children Act 1989).
2. Children who live within the catchment area served by the school with brothers or sisters attending the school at the proposed time of admission.
3. Other children living in catchment - applications will be assessed from the address the parents are living, at the closing date, and will be reassessed on the National Offer Date.
4. Brothers or sisters of children still attending the school at the time of their admission, but not living within the school's catchment area.
5. Children who are not living within the school's catchment area. If places remain beyond criteria 4, then these will be allocated on proximity to the school measured 'as the crow flies' from the entrance to the child's home to the principal entrance of the main administrative building of the school.
6. Other children.



## Wrap around care “Oak Rangers”

- ▶ At Oak Grange will run a breakfast and an afterschool club for Oak Grange children.
